Steering extenders are supplied by SkyWest and will be sent via FedEx next week.

Last year, Teams could cut the dash around the steering column, can we cut ours?

Yes, cutting the dash gives drivers more room. However, you may only cut the dash panel that has the notch cut out for the steering column.
